

Charter for using the blog on the www.chablis.fr website

• **The aim of the blog:**

This blog is moderated post-publication. This means that all posts are read after they have been published on the blog. It may take up to three days before messages are moderated.

The moderator monitors and manages discussions. Their role is not to censure, rather to check that language used in the forums remains courteous, respectful and law-abiding.

The moderator will delete any messages:

- That are insulting or defamatory
- That have an advertising or promotional aim
- That are racist or homophobic
- That include addresses or telephone numbers
- That are unintelligible, off-subject or repeated in several different discussions

This list is non-exhaustive. The BIVB reserves the right to delete any other messages that do not fall into one of these categories.

• **Responsibility**

Users alone are responsible for the information, messages, images, and in general terms, all content they post on the blog. The BIVB may take the initiative, without providing any formal notice, to delete, either totally or in part, any content posted on the blog, if the said content does not conform to any current laws or rules, or decent conduct. In the case of repeated abuse, and depending on the circumstances, the BIVB may make a formal complaint, and/or may seek compensation. The BIVB will make the IP addresses of any users involved available to the authorities.

• **Copyright**

A reminder of French law: it is not permitted to copy a complete article published on another site or in a newspaper to the forum as this is in breach of copyright, even if the information mentioned below is included. However, it is possible to quote a story (according to article L.122-5 CPI = copyright exception). When quoting an article, the title and the author must be cited as well as the source. It is possible to post a link to a website containing the article one is quoting from. The link will open in a new page, clearly showing the other site.
